PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On Sunday, the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb to pray. Jesus had freed her from seven demons. She and the twelve Apostles had accompanied Jesus as he preached and proclaimed the good news of the Kingdom of God from one town and village to another. (Luke 8: 1-3)

Along with Mary, the Blessed Mother, and the beloved disciple, Mary of Magdala stayed with Jesus as he hung dying upon the Cross. She heard him say, "It is finished." (John 19: 25-30) She saw our Lord placed in the arms of his Mother. She saw our Lord placed in the tomb. She witnessed the heavy stone slammed in place at the entrance to the tomb. She would never forget that sound. The sound of death and desolation. It is finished? What did he mean?

Now, Sunday, this first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb to pray. She stayed with her Lord in life, she would pray at his tomb in death. What's this? The stone is removed. Have they now stolen his body? They couldn't let him rest in peace? Peter and the beloved disciples are summoned, "They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don't know where they put him." (John 20: 1-10) They are as stunned as Mary of Magdala. They enter the empty tomb. The burial cloths are in one place; the cloth that had covered his head rolled up in another. What does it mean?

Mary of Magdala came to the tomb to pray. And so should we. Through our prayers we will come to understand that Jesus was not taken from the tomb. Jesus rose from the dead and removed the clothes of death. Jesus is risen! Alleluia! Jesus our Lord and our Savior has conquered death and desolation. His life is our life.

Live his life even now. We are a resurrection people. We walk with the Lord of life. We breath in his Spirit. We share his life with those around us.

Jesus, Risen Lord, let me live your life, let us live your life, now and forever. Amen. Alleluia!

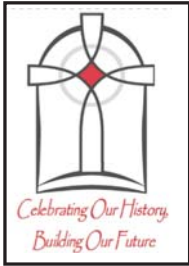

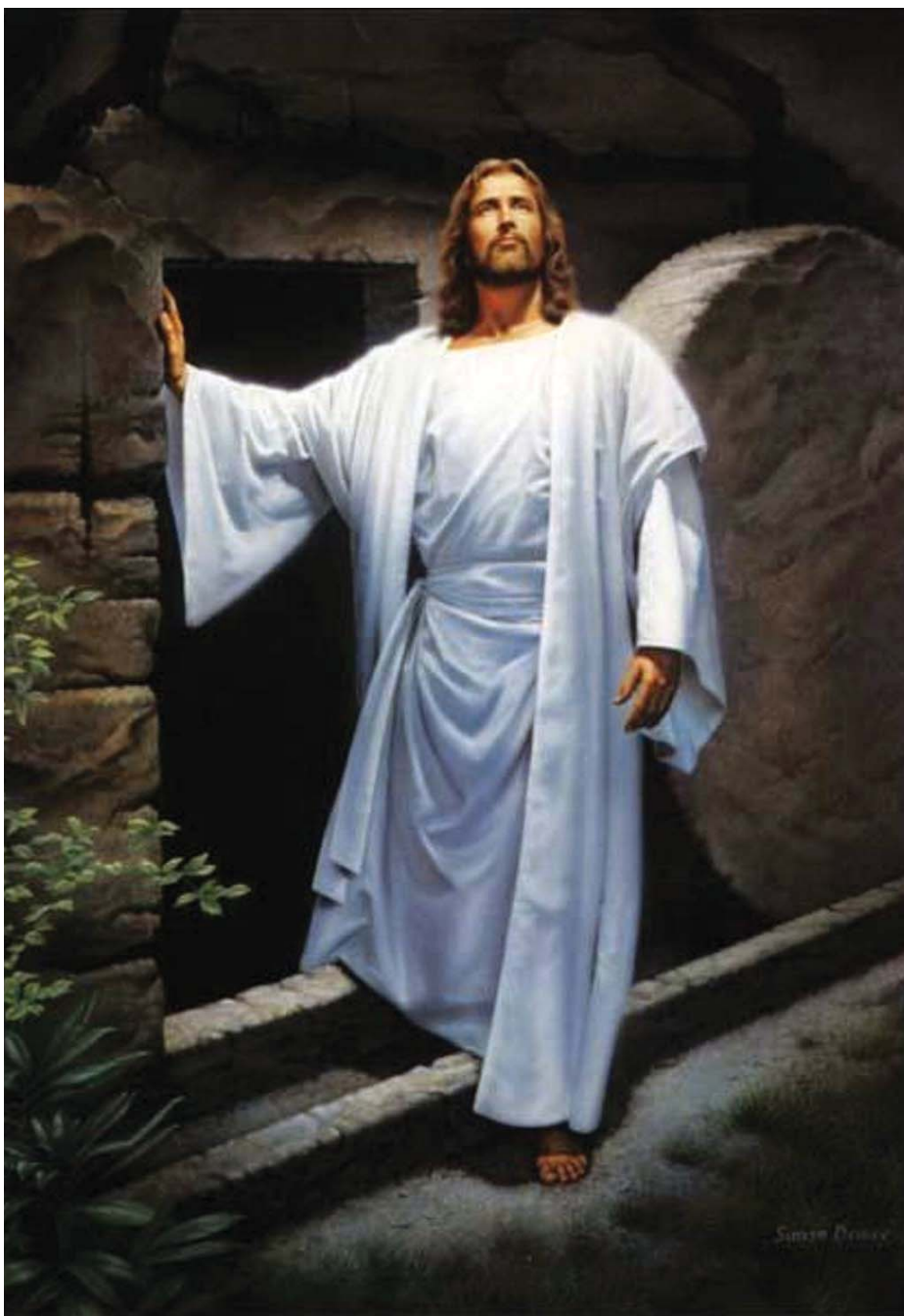
