Luke 24:32

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Easter Season continues until Pentecost Sunday, June 4. Today is the Third Sunday of Easter. In the Gospel reading today (Luke 24: 13-35), two of the disciples encountered the resurrected Jesus on the road to Emmaus. It says that "their eyes were prevented from recognizing him." It also says that the two disciples were "conversing and debating." When Jesus asked what they were discussing, one of them, named Cleopas, said they were talking about Jesus the Nazarene, "who was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people." They went on to say how the "chief priests and rulers both handed Jesus over to a sentence of death and crucified him." But it doesn't end there, "Some women from our group, however, have astounded us; they were at the tomb early in the morning and did not find the body; they came back and reported that they had indeed seen a vision of angels who announced that he was alive."

Then the resurrected Jesus spoke to these two disciples, "Oh, how foolish you are! How slow of heart to believe all that the prophets spoke! Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory!" Jesus then interpreted for them all the Scriptures that referred to him. Wouldn't you love to have Jesus interpret the Scriptures for you?

The disciples invite Jesus to stay with them. Then comes an early account of a Eucharistic Liturgy, "And it happened that, while [Jesus] was with them at table, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them. With that their eyes were opened and they recognized him, but he vanished from their sight. Then they said to each other, 'Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?'" They immediately went back to Jerusalem and are greeted with, "'The Lord has truly been raised and has appeared to Simon!' Then the two recounted what had happened on the way and how he was made known to them in the breaking of the bread."

This is what happens at Mass. During the Liturgy of the Word we walk with Jesus through the Scriptures and with the help of the homily, the priest interprets what the Scriptures say about Jesus. Then the priest blesses bread and wine and pronounces the words of Jesus, "This is my Body; and This is my Blood." The early Church called the Mass, "The Breaking of the Bread."

Like the disciples in this Gospel account, may our hearts always burn within us as Jesus speaks to us in the Scriptures. May our hearts burn within us as we encounter our Lord in Holy Communion.

The Lord has truly been raised and has appeared to us!
