PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Jesus tells us that the kingdom of heaven is like good seed sown in a field that also contains weeds. It is like a mustard seed that is small but grows into a large shrub. It is like yeast put into dough that when baked is enough to feed a hundred people. It is like a treasure buried in a field or a pearl so valuable that the one who finds the treasure or the pearl sells everything to have them. The kingdom of heaven is also like a net thrown into the sea that collects a lot of fish that are then separated into good and bad with the bad thrown away. (Matthew 13)

Jesus taught through parables. According to the commentary to the Revised New American Bible, a New Testament parable "designates stories that are illustrative comparisons between Christian truths and events of everyday life." Something in the parable gets the hearer's attention like the yeast in the huge amount of dough prepared by one person. Those listening might say, "that doesn't make sense" or "that wouldn't happen." And that's the hook that gets their attention.

Jesus used parables to help his disciples enter into great mysteries that were beyond human understanding. Our human mind could never on its own understand the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, of the Holy Trinity, of the Body and Blood of Christ, of the Lord's unbounded forgiveness, and so much more.

Like the first disciples of Jesus, we also need to ask the Lord to explain these mysteries to us. We need to continue to learn our faith. We can't just rely on what we learned in our First Communion and Confirmation classes. Faith formation is life-long. Would you go to a doctor who never took another continuing education course after he passed his medical boards? Isn't our spiritual health more important? Everybody should have a copy of the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*. We should have copies in the office or you can purchase it at a Catholic book store. You can see an online version at www.usccb.org. Go to the header: "Beliefs and Teachings" and then down to "What We Believe." In the left margin you will see: "Catechism of the Catholic Church." However, I prefer the paper copy. Along with this you have to spend time with the Lord in prayer. If you want to spend eternity with our Lord, it's important you spend time each day with him. Find a quiet corner in your house away from electronic devices and other distractions. Come to church and spend some time with the Body of Christ our Lord present in the tabernacle.

Is the kingdom of God worth more than a buried treasure and the most valuable pearl in the world? Are there a lot of weeds in your field making it hard to find the kingdom of God? Turn to the Lord, pray to the Lord. Please also pray for those around you who also long for the kingdom of God. Remember, you want to be in the presence of God forever. But you won't be alone. As it says in the Book of Revelation:

After this I had a vision of great multitude, which no one could count, from every nation, race, people, and tongue. They stood before the throne and before the Lamb, wearing white robes and holding palm branches in their hands. They cried out in a loud voice: "Salvation comes from our God, who is seated on the throne, and from the Lamb" (Revelations 7:9-10).

So along with the Lord in the kingdom of God, you will be with a lot of other people. Most likely it will be the people next to you right now. Shouldn't you spend time with those you are going to spend eternity with?

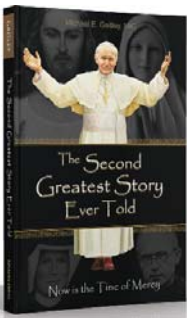


ALTAR SERVER TRAINING

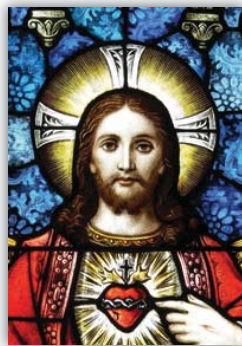

100th Anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima

Indulgence Opportunities During the Centennial Anniversary of the Apparitions of Our Lady in Fatima, Portugal

Pope Francis has granted a plenary indulgence opportunity for the 100th anniversary of the Fatima apparitions throughout the centennial year, from November 27, 2016 until November 26, 2017.

There are three ways to obtain the indulgence, detailed in a statement from the Fatima Shrine in Portugal (World Apostolate of Fatima website: <https://wafusa.org/pope-francis-grants-plenary-indulgence-for-jubilee-year-of-fatima/>).

To obtain the plenary indulgence, the faithful must also fulfill the ordinary conditions: go to Confession and Communion, be interiorly detached from sin, and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father.

1. Make a pilgrimage to the Shrine in Fatima, Portugal

To the faithful who make a pilgrimage to the Fatima Shrine in Portugal and participate in a celebration of prayer dedicated to the Virgin. In addition, the faithful must pray the Our Father, recite the Creed and invoke the Mother of God.

2. Pray before any statue of Our Lady of Fatima

To the faithful who visit with devotion a statue of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly exposed for public veneration in any church, oratory or proper place during the days of the anniversary of the apparitions, the 13th of each month from May to October 2017, and there devoutly participate in some celebration or prayer in honor of the Virgin Mary. In addition, the faithful must pray the Our Father, recite the Creed and invoke Our Lady of Fatima. **ST. BONAVENTURE CHURCH has a statue of Our Lady of Fatima near the tabernacle. It will remain in our church until October 21 when we will have a closing celebration of the centennial year.**

3. The elderly and infirm

To the faithful who, because of age, illness or other serious cause, are unable to get around, may pray in front of a statue of Our Lady of Fatima and must spiritually unite themselves to the jubilee celebrations on the days of the apparitions, the 13th of each month, between May and October 2017. They must also "offer to merciful God with confidence, through Mary, their prayers and sufferings or the sacrifices they make in their own lives."

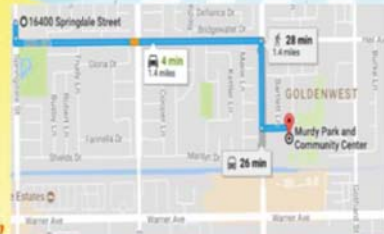
