## PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We have this image of the members of the early Church as caring for each other and always getting along. (Acts 2:42-47) However, this Sunday's Gospel (Matthew 18:15-20) reminds us that this was not always the case: "If your brother sins against you, go tell him his fault between you and him alone." You don't talk behind your brother's back. You don't tell everybody else but not the one who has hurt you. You go straight to that person. If that person won't listen, you still must try to bring healing through two or three witnesses, through the church, and through the prayer of two or three.

Jesus wants us to do everything possible to bring peace and reconciliation to the church community. Unity is a sign of the presence of Jesus in our midst. Division is a sign that we are listening to the evil one and not to the Lord. Jesus says, "If he refuses to listen even to the church, then treat him as you would a Gentile or a tax collector." However, how did Jesus treat the Gentile woman who begged him to heal her daughter? Even though Jesus told her that he was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel, our Lord recognized her deep faith and cured her daughter. (Matthew 15:21-28) How did Jesus treat tax collectors? He called Matthew the tax collector to be one of his apostles. (Matthew 9:9-13) He told Zacchaeus the chief tax collector that he needed to have dinner in his house. (Luke 19:1-10)

Jesus will continue to call us to forgiveness and reconciliation in next Sunday's Gospel. (Matthew 18:21-35)


Merciful Lord, we need your help to bring unity and peace to our church family. All things are possible when we put our faith in you. Soften hardened and unforgiving hearts. Help us bring healing to those we have wounded. Help us to love one another as you have loved us.

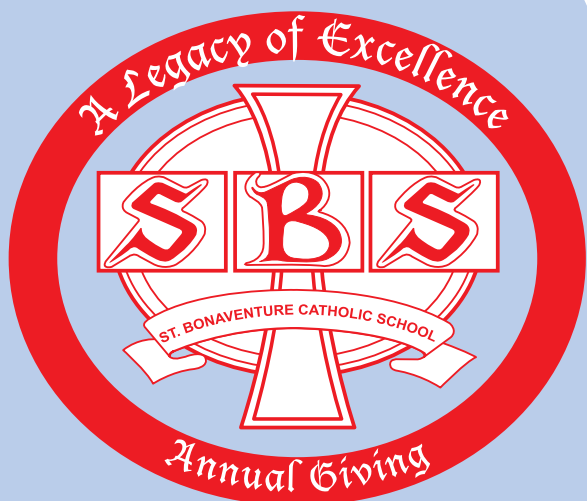
