Parable of the UNFORGIVING SERVANT

Matthew 18:21-35

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In this Sunday's Gospel (Matthew 18:21-35) St. Peter thought he was being generous when he asked Jesus, "Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive? As many as seven times?" The response of Jesus must have shocked him, "I say to you, not seven times but seventy-seven times."

The number seven stood for "perfection" or "without limit." Therefore, seventy-seven means that we must forgive each and every time we are offended. We pray this in the Our Father, "forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." An older version of the Lord's Prayer prays, "forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors." (Matthew 16:12)

This ties in well with the parable Jesus tells in Matthew chapter 18, "The kingdom of heaven may be likened to a king who decided to settle accounts with his servants." One debtor owed a huge amount and was about to be sold along with his family and property to pay the debt. The servant pleaded with the king who took pity on him and cancelled the debt. But then the servant encountered someone who owed him a small debt, "Pay back what you owe." The fellow servant pleaded with him, "Be patient with me, and I will pay you back." But he refused and had him thrown into prison until he paid the debt. When the king found out, he confronted the unforgiving servant, "I forgave you your entire debt because you begged me to. Should you not have had pity on your fellow servant, as I had pity on you?" The king handed him over to the torturers until he paid back the whole debt. The moral of the parable is important for us to hear, "So will my heavenly Father do to you, unless each of you forgives his brother from his heart."

We need to remember that our sins are debts that we could never repay. Yet the Lord cancelled the debt of our sins because he loves us. Through his death on the Cross, Jesus cancelled the debt of our sins. We encounter our forgiving Lord in the Sacrament of Penance (Confession). Our grateful response needs to be forgiving our brothers and sisters from our heart. The kingdom of heaven is for those who seek the Lord's forgiveness. The kingdom of heaven is for those who are able to forgive.

Merciful Lord, thank you for your great gift of forgiveness. Please give us a forgiving heart. Forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors.

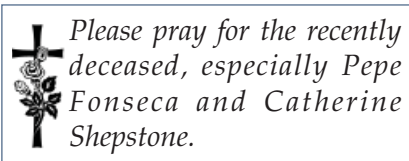

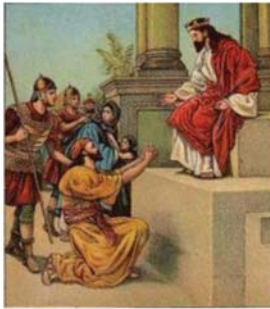
