PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In the first reading this Sunday, the great Old Testament prophet Isaiah tells us, "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways, says the Lord. As high as the heavens are above the earth, so are my ways above your ways and my thoughts above your thoughts" (Isaiah 55:8-9).

This definitely comes across in the parable that Jesus tells in today's Gospel passage, "The kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out at dawn to hire laborers for his vineyard. After agreeing with them for the usual daily wage, he sent them into his vineyard" (Matthew 20:1-16). Some of those listening to Jesus could identify with those day laborers. They probably were hoping for a day's wage for a day's work. Then Jesus tells them that the landowner hired more workers at nine, noon, three, and five o'clock. Then Jesus tells them that they all received the same wage.

Now this gets their attention. "Wait a minute, that's not fair." They probably echoed the gripe of the workers, "These last ones worked only one hour, and you have made them equal to us, who bore the day's burden and the heat." Now Jesus has their attention. Remember his opening sentence: "The kingdom of heaven is like ..." Jesus isn't talking about unfair labor practices. Jesus is talking about the kingdom of heaven.

Let me give you an example. Many years ago, I visited a critically ill man in the hospital at the request of his wife. The man was a gruff old man. His wife was Catholic but her husband had never been baptized. She had asked him many times if he wanted to become Catholic and his response was always, "No." After several years and she was still asking, his response was, "No, and stop asking." He didn't mind me visiting and praying with him, but his wife told me he didn't want to be Catholic. She called me a few days later and told me her husband was dying. She also told me she decided to ask him one more time, "Do you want to be baptized," and this time he shook his head, up and down indicating "yes." When I arrived I asked him, "Do you want to be baptized?" He shook his head up and down. "Do you believe in God the Father, Creator of Heaven and earth? Do you believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. ... Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting?" He shook his head up and down to each question. I baptized him, "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." As I wiped the water that ran down the side of his face, I saw a tear running down his cheek.

"Go forth, Christian soul, from this world in the name of God the almighty Father, who created you, in the name of Jesus Christ, Son of the living God, who suffered for you, in the name of the Holy Spirit, who was poured out upon you, go forth, faithful Christian. May you live in peace this day, may your home be with God, with Mary, the Mother of God, with Joseph, and all the angels and saints." (*Pastoral Care of the Sick, Prayers-Commendation of the Dying*)

It is definitely best to not put off to the end of life our covenant with the Lord. You know neither the day nor the hour when the Lord will require your life.

Whether you've been laboring in the vineyard of the Lord for many years or for just a short time, the Lord invites you to live your life preparing for the kingdom of heaven. Be true to the commandments of the Lord. Love God with your whole heart and your neighbor as yourself. "Conduct your life in a way worthy of the Gospel of Christ" (Philippians 1:27).

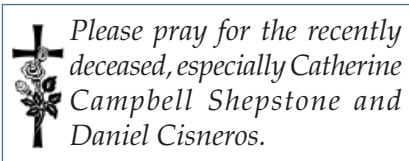
