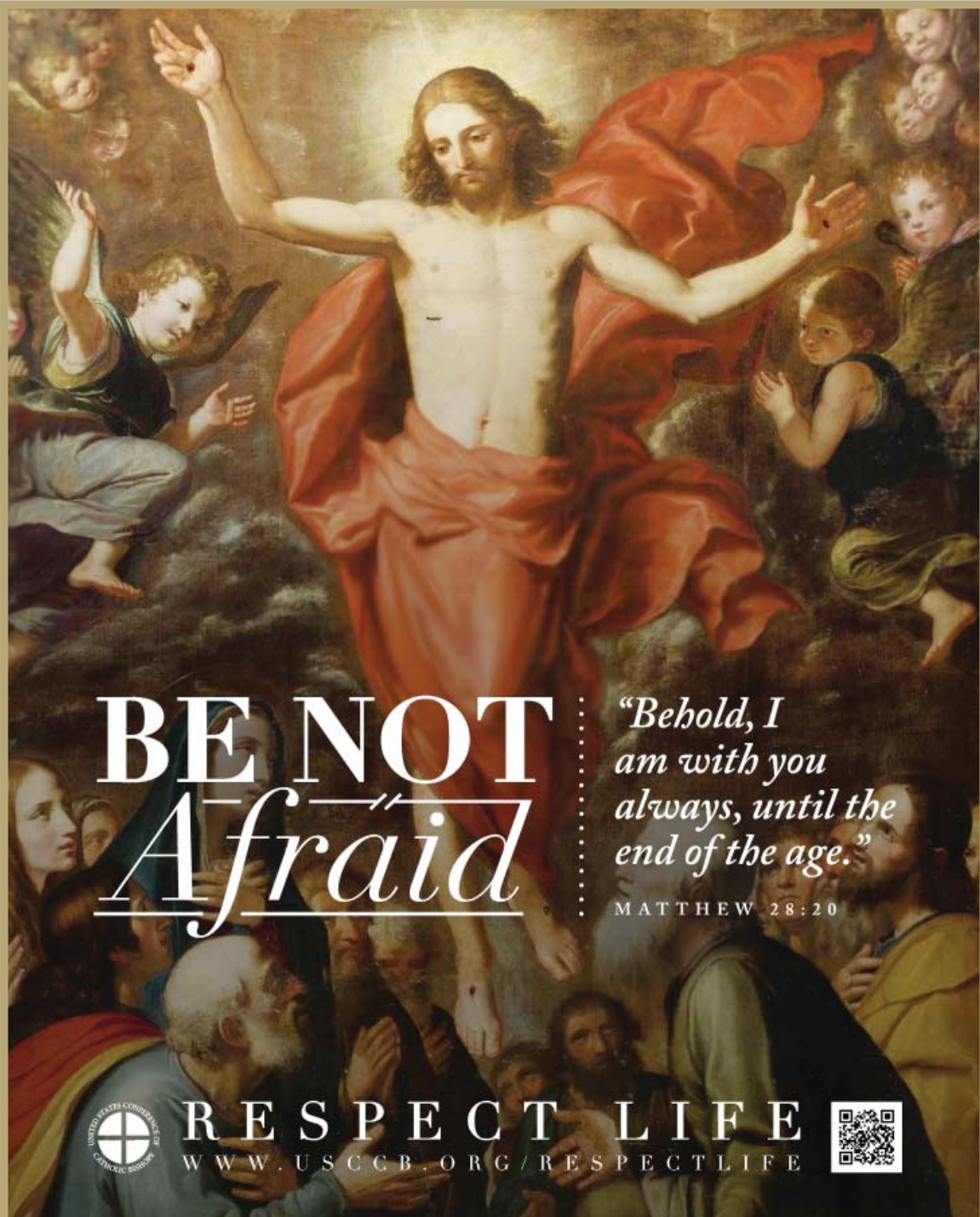

## PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

St. Paul in this Sunday's Second Scripture Reading includes the following passages:

Do nothing out of selfishness or out of vainglory; rather, humbly regard others as more important than yourselves, each looking out not for his own interests, but also for those of others. Have in you the same attitude that is also in Christ Jesus (Philippians 2:1-11).

Today is Respect Life Sunday. Every day needs to be a day that we respect life. Every human being is created in the image of God. That begins at conception and continues into eternity.

We are called to respect children in the womb. "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I dedicated you" (Jeremiah 1: 5). We are called to respect the elderly in nursing homes. We must remember that God is the Creator of every human being. He is in charge, not us. Parents are called to be stewards of the God-given life of their children. Just as the day will come when their children will become stewards of their parents' God-given life when they are old and frail and need to be cared for. "My son, be steadfast in honoring your father; do not grieve him as long as he lives. Even if his mind fails, be considerate to him; do not revile him because you are in your prime (Sirach 3:12-13).

I ask you to offer the following prayer:

God, our Creator, we give thanks to you, who alone have the power to impart the breath of life as you form each of us in our mother's womb; grant, we pray, that we, whom you have made stewards of creation, may remain faithful to this sacred trust and constant in safeguarding the dignity of every human life. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God for ever and ever. Amen.

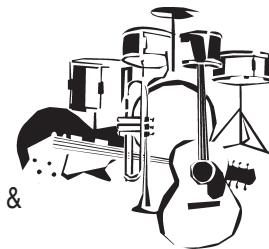

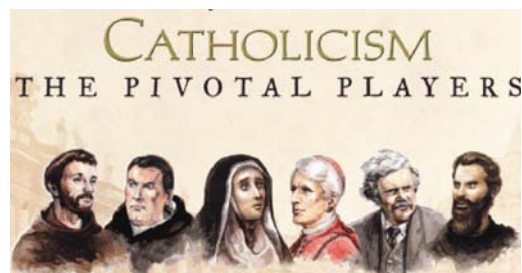


**THURSDAY MORNING SCRIPTURE STUDY**

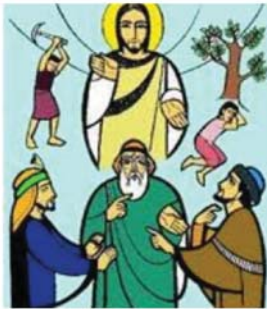
